

Presenting UpToYou to Catholic Schools in Navarra

The Federation of Catholic Schools of Navarra organized an *UpToYou* training. Three Navarrese centers attended the training in November 2017.

Throughout three days of training the attendees were able to correctly conceptualize what emotion is and therefore, emotional education. They discovered the different ways education can be understood, and lastly they understood all the elements that converge on emotions.

Some of the concepts discussed at this training were: foundations, distinction among different models of emotional education and examples of educational intervention.





Spain



UpToYou training educators in Valencia (Spain)

The first *UpToYou* training took place last February 19th in Valencia. It was addressed to teachers, educators, parents, catechists and people over 18 years old.

The attendees were able to listen, understand and work on the main goals of the program: allowing the person to go on a personal growth journey whose first step is accepting reality itself, which is discovered through their emotional situation.

Over several days, during the months of January and February, in sessions from Friday to Sunday, the 54 participants could enjoy *UpToYou*.

Navarra holds a very successful UpToYou training



Around 50 people from different schools, institutions, mothers, fathers and young people of all ages are attending an *UpToYou* training in Navarra which will take place throughout several weekends in the months of May and June.

The project, which has been made possible thanks to several entities (Foro Europeo, Concapa, ICS University of Navarra, Asociación Navarra de Familias Numerosas and Fundación Caja Navarra), has turned out very successful.

As it is part of the program, other than assisting the sessions, the participants will have to find short moments during the week to work own their own.

UpToYou with the Poor Clares

A total of 9 days between May 17th and June 16th, 27 nuns gathered in Belorado (Burgos) to attend the *UpToYou* training.

Coming from their monasteries in Belorado, Derio, Arnedo, Castrojeriz, Borja and Gernika, the nuns, of ages between 25 to 40 years old, completed the *UpToYou* training as part of their personal training, since we all need to learn about our emotions.





Mexico

UpToYou on a tour through several cities and universities

There were many places where *UpToYou* left its mark this past March. As part of a five weeks academic stay, *UpToYou* stopped at Puebla, Aguascalientes, Veracruz and Queretaro.

The main destination this time was the university of Puebla Universidad Popular Autónomadel Estado de Puebla (UPAEP).

The main reason for this stay at UPAEP was the opening of a line of research on emotional education similar to that of *UpToYou*. If everything goes according to plan, this work will result in a partnership program between UNAV (University of Navarra) and the UPAEP.

During his time there, the director of *UpToYou*, José Víctor Orón, explained that emotions are an effect of the complexity of humans' life, therefore they can no longer be considered haphazard but they become logical, though complex, while they provide information of one's personal state. He asserted that he has observed a worldwide tendency to make education more and more technical; the key to the student's success is to obtain good qualifications. In addition, he presented the philosophical, neuroscientific and psychological foundations of the different proposals on emotional education.





Mexico



During the weekends *UpToYou* team visited other universities in Mexico. Thanks to the iniciative of the Department of Humanities at Cristobal Colón University (Veracruz), *UpToYou* presented the conference: "Emotional education in the educational process". The goal was to set general strategies to be implemented by teachers in order to promote the development of emotional education among university students.

The conference was presented in two encounters. Firstly it was presented to academics from the Department of Education Sciences and Psychology, alongside tutors from other Bachelor degrees at Cristobal Colón Universtiy. Secondly the conference was shared with a bigger audience, including Colegio Colón, Colegio Calasancio Nuevo Veracruz and Escuela Calasanz. At a meeting with the dean it was discussed the possibility to reach an agreement between Cristobal Colón and UNAV (University of Navarra) for the development of *UpToYou*.

Another visit was paid to the Universidad Panamericana's headquarters in Aguascalientes. The foundations of *UpToYou* were also introduced to students from the psychology and pedagogy degree at a lunch meeting with interested professors, as well as at a dinner meeting with students of the last year of the psychology degree.

Finally, the program was presented at the research center CISAV in Querétaro.



Brazil

UpToYou training educators in Cachoirea Paulista – Unidades sociales

During the days the training took place, we were able to clarify many terms were, share some experiences and above all, encourage person growth. *UpToYou* team landed in Cachoirea Paulista (Brazil) last January 18th to develop the training for a total of 25 social educators and 50 teachers all belonging to the institution Canção Nova.

The team of social educators received a 21 hours training course from January 23rd to 27th, divided into several morning and afternoon sessions. The work carried out continued the one which started in January 2016 with a similar format. With this second part, educators have already completed modules 1 and 2 of the *UpToYou* training.

Due to the success and good results that came out of the experience, it anticipated that for the next academic year 2017/2018 the social educators will apply the *UpToYou* program not only on their students but also on themselves, since it is a great opportunity to revisit and renew the relationships with the student.





Brazil

UpToYou training educators in Cachoirea Paulista – Institute

At its second stay in Cachoirea Paulista *UpToYou* organized a training for 50 teachers of the Cançao Nova Institute. The whole group was able to enjoy an interesting training from January 18th to January 20th in morning and afternoon sessions. These sessions have also continued the ones which conducted with a similar format in January 2016.

They have been a few days of great work, in which we shared experiences, concepts, and new ways of understanding teaching.

Due to the good results, it was decided that the teachers will apply the program on themselves to start a process to renew their educative approach.

UpToYou with the centre for Philosophy for Children

Next June 28th, throughout several days, the program Philosophy for Children will hold an International Congress in which *UpToYou* will be introduced and we will study how both program can help improve each other.

Philosophy for Children is a non-profit organization whose aim is to contribute with its activity to renewing and perfecting education throughout life, both in a formal and an informal environment, emphasizing the development of the ability to think by one's self within a community of philosophical research.

All their training and educative actions have one main goal, contributing to the development of more critical, reasoning and democratic people, encouraging the necessary skills for an autonomous thinking which learns to reflect in a constant dialogue with others in a community of philosophical research. The synergy created from merging both projects, FpN and *UpToYou*, could be really interesting and fruitful.





Congresses

Presenting UpToYou at the International Congress of Scholas Occurrentes. Israel. (Jerusalem)

The presentation will take place next June. Last March 'Scholas Occurrentes- UpToYou' signed an agreement which will promote actions aimed at the education for peace, inclusion, emotional education, social integration and training in values.
